It is recommended to use a large-diaphragm microphone into the front of the Kenwood TS-590S. Excellent microphone options: Electro-Voice RE27N/D Dynamic Cardioid Multipurpose Microphone, Electro Voice RE-20 Cardioid Microphone, Heil PR 781, Heil Goldline GM-5, or possibly the Heil PR-40 Dynamic Studio Recording Microphone.

Outboard audio gear is not normally used with the Kenwood 590. The inboard 18 band equalizer provides very suitable TX audio quality. It is important to get the right setup.
